MEMORANDUM FOR: Senior Army Instructors/Army Instructors, Army JROTC Units

SUBJECT: BASSETT HIGH SCHOOL JROTC Seventh Annual Drill Meet, 30 September 2017

1. PURPOSE: To provide information concerning the administration and conduct of the Seventh Annual Bassett High School JROTC Drill Meet to be held on Saturday, 30 September, 2017 at 0830. At Bassett High School.

2. ADMINISTRATION:

- a. Location: Bassett High School, Bassett 85 riverside Dr. Bassett, Virginia 24055
- b. Fees, Registration and Events: There will be a \$100.00 non-refundable entry fee. This amount will allow units to participate in all of the drill events including knockout. Checks should be made payable to Bassett High School JROTC and received with the entry form no later than 15 September 2017. The events available to compete in are Junior Varsity and Varsity Individual w/Arms, Varsity Color Guard, Junior Varsity and Varsity Unarmed Squad, Varsity Armed Squad, Varsity Unarmed Platoon and Platoon Inspection. A knockout event will be held at the end of the drill competition.
- c. Phone number to Bassett JROTC (direct line): (276) 629-1154. We would appreciate a call indicating your interest in the meet to get an idea of the number of attendees.
- d. There will be a very short Commander's meeting at 0815 on 30 September 2017, in the auditorium. The order of March will be disseminated at this meeting.
- e. Concession stands will be available for soft drinks, snacks, pizza, nachos and cheese, etc., in the concession area of the school. Come and support the school and area!
- f. There are no separate male and female events. Teams may be all male or female or mixed. All events will be judged under one category.

3. OPERATIONS:

- a. Varsity Limitations: Schools may enter only one team per event in the Color Guard, Platoon Events, and Armed Squad. **Schools may enter two teams consisting of two representatives to compete in the Armed Individual event meaning, one as the command caller and one as the executioner, One JV team (meaning cadets are LET 1) and a Varsity team consisting of upper LETS.** There is no limit of entrance in the Knockout event. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- b. JV Limitations: Schools may enter two teams (varsity and JV) in the following events; Unarmed squad, and Armed Individuals.
- c. Uniform: The uniform for this event is Class A and B regulation issued cadet uniforms. All authorized items should be worn (rank, ribbons, medals, etc.). Boots may not be worn. Headgear will be the issued gray berets. Gloves, scarves/ascots, pistol belts may be worn at the discretion of the unit cadre.
- d. Weapons: There are no restrictions on the type of rifles that units may use during the competition Units are reminded of their responsibility to ensure weapons are secure at all times.

e. Inspection: The inspection will count in the overall results of the drill competition. It will be conducted separately from all other events. The location of this inspection will be announced at the Commander's Caucus . Platoon Leaders should be familiar with how to prepare their element for inspection (Fall-In, Open Ranks, Dress Right, reporting in to the inspecting officer etc.). Every command should be correctly given once the inspecting person tells the Platoon Leader to prepare for the inspection IAW FM 3-21.5. A total of two questions will be asked of each cadet during the inspection. Questions will be Chain-of-Command, Winning Colors, Drill & Ceremonies, and other basic cadet knowledge questions. Unit size for inspection should be three squads of four cadets plus one Platoon Leader/Commander (13 cadets).

f. Judging: This event will be judged by local military members.

g. Unit Size:

1. Platoon-13 individuals minimum, including the Commander/Leader.
2. Squad: 7 individuals minimum, including Commander.
3. Color Guard: Total of 4 individuals.
4. Individual: One cadet to perform, one cadet to call commands which are memorized.

h. Schedule: Drill meet will begin immediately following the Commander's Meeting.

4. Awards: Awards will be presented immediately after the last unit has completed their drill and the scores have been tabulated. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each event including knockout. Overall trophies will be awarded for 1st thru 3rd place in every event . The overall winner will be determined as the unit having the most quality points in all events except Knockout. Ties will be broken by the number of fives (5) a team gets on that event. In the event of a tie for one of the overall positions we will use the teams that are tied scores in the Color Guard event to break that tie and determine the overall winner

Quality points will be awarded as follows:

1. First place in an event – 6 quality points.
2. Second place in an event – 4 quality points.
3. Third place in an event –3 quality points.
4. Fourth place in an event – 2 quality point.
5. Entry in any event (Except Knockout)- 1 quality point
