The 2017 Walhalla AJROTC Razorback Rifle Shootout will be held **5 Oct – 7 Oct 2017** at Walhalla High School in Walhalla, SC. This match is a CMP Cup Match and EIC points will be awarded. Please visit the CMP website at www.odcmp.com and register your shooters for CMP competitor numbers. COL Kevin Mangan – Walhalla HS Army JROTC - is the match director.

LOCATION: Walhalla High School is located at **4701 N. Highway 11, Walhalla, SC 29691**. There will be thirty-two firing points. All targets will be mounted prior to the competition.

ELIGIBILITY: All sporter teams may participate. Teams will consist of four members; no competitor may be a member of more than one team. Individual shooters may participate.

RULES: The *2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules* will govern (downloadable at <http://www.odcmp.com/3p.htm>). The use of Clear Barrel Indicators (CBIs) and other safety aspects outlined in the JROTC Marksmanship Instructor Training Course (JMIC) is required.

EQUIPMENT: This is a Sporter class competition with rifles limited to National Three Position Air Rifle Council approved rifles. Each school will provide their own pellets; only .177 wadcutter (flat-nosed) pellets are permitted. Coaches should review the *2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules* with regard to equipment and shooter clothing.

COURSE OF FIRE: Competitors will shoot one 3x20 course (20 prone, 20 standing, 20 kneeling). There will be no final. There will be individual and team competitions. There will be an optional unofficial – “guts” match immediately following the 3x20 match.

CONDUCT OF MATCH: IAW the *2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules*, AR-5/10 targets (provided) are hung at the start of each relay. The positions will be fired in timed stages (20 minutes prone, 25 minutes standing, 20 minutes kneeling). Shooters will have a 8 minute preparation/sighting period prior to the prone stage, and 5 minute changeover, 5 minute sighting times after the prone and standing stages.

COACHING: Coaching assistance on the firing line will be allowed during the preparation period and sighting shots only. After the first record shot is complete, shooters may not return to the sighting targets and may not receive further coaching. **NEW SHOOTER COACHING:** This is an early match in the season. Coaching of new shooters will be allowed during record fire for safety as long as it does not distract other competitors.

SQUADDING: All members of a team will be on the same relay. Teams will be assigned relays based on their entry request and availability when their entry request is received.

RELAY SCHEDULE: Teams should arrive at the range **no later than 45 minutes prior** to their assigned relay time. Shooters should report to the ready line no later than 10 minutes before their relay to begin their setup. There will be an 8 minute preparation/sighting period, with 5 minutes changeover periods between the following positions IAW current rules.

Relay 1:	1230-1430 Thursday – 5 October
Relay 2:	1500-1700 Thursday – 5 October
Relay 3:	1030-1230 Friday – 6 October (If needed)
Relay 4:	1300-1500 Friday – 6 October
Relay 5:	1530-1730 Friday – 6 October
Relay 6:	1800-2015 Friday – 6 October (If needed)
Relay 7:	1000-1200 Saturday – 7 October
Relay 8:	1230-1430 Saturday – 7 October
Relay 9:	1500-1700 Saturday – 7 October (If needed)

SCORING TARGETS: Targets will be scored IAW the *2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules*. The Orion scoring system will be used for target scoring. The official results list will be posted after the last challenge period and available on Orion results center.

CHALLENGE PERIOD: Targets should be ready for challenge within 15 minutes of the end of the relay. There is no fee for challenges.

ENTRY FEES and REGISTRATION: Coaches must check-in and designate their teams NLT 45 minutes prior to their relay. Teams will not be rearranged after first competition shot on relay. Entry fee is \$60.00 per team. Fees may be mailed or hand carried to Walhalla High School Army JROTC.

AWARDS: The following awards will be given:

Individual Awards.

- The top ten shooters overall in the open category will receive an award.
- The top five shooters overall in the first-year category will receive an award.
- Shooters may not win awards in both the open and first-year categories. First-year shooters earning an open award will come off first year shooter category. (A first year shooter has not shot on a competitive marksmanship team prior to 1 June 2017).
- A Razorback Shootout T-Shirt will be given to all participants.
- CMP Achievement Pins will be awarded to all shooters who meet the following criteria in the 3x20 format.
 - Gold Achievement Pin: 490 points or higher
 - Silver Achievement Pin: 440-489 points
 - Bronze Achievement Pin: 400-439 points
- **CMP Excellence-in-Competition Points.** This is a CMP Cup match. Individual finishers will receive Excellence-in-Competition Credit Points in accordance with the 2016-2018 National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules. Currently 530 minimum score for EIC points.

Team Awards:

- **Overall Team Championship.** The number of team trophies will be based on the number of teams in the competition. Up to thirteen teams, there will be three team trophies; if fourteen to twenty-four teams, there will be four team trophies; there will be five trophies if more than twenty-four teams.
- **New Shooter Team** – Will award 1st Place to the top team made up of all new shooters.
- Awards will be mailed to teams & individuals ASAP after competition completion.
